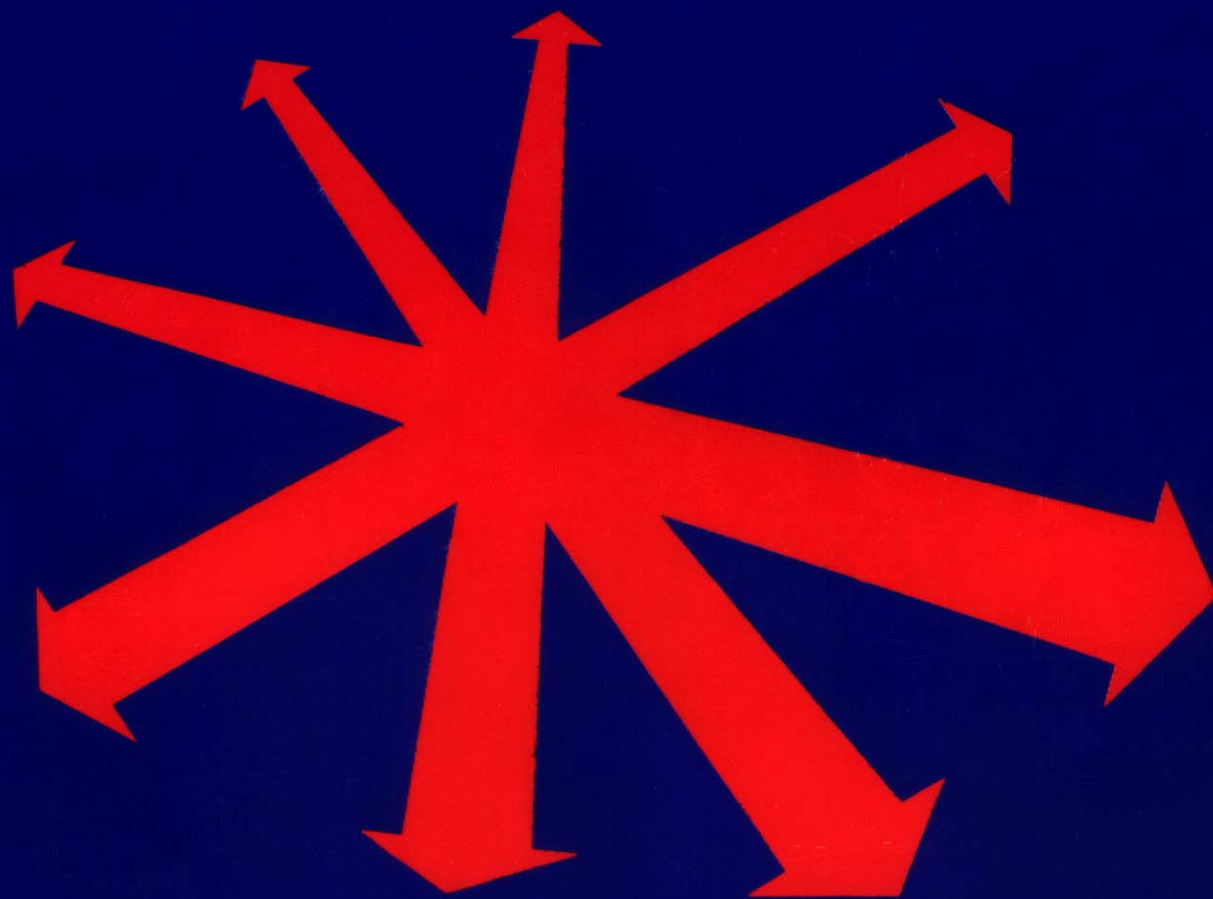



PREFACE

It has been evident for a number of years that a publication containing detailed statistical information on Newfoundland and Labrador was urgently required. This need has been expressed repeatedly by various royal commissions, by numerous departments and agencies of all levels of government, by consultants and researchers and by the general public. The publication of this volume of statistics will help to alleviate the necessity of referring to numerous sources for required data.

This original publication is designed to be a foundation document. It is intended to release annual supplements updating the data presented in each of the tables contained in this volume and adding newly developed statistical series. The supplementary volumes will be much less comprehensive in terms of the period covered and they will not contain the elaborate explanatory notes supplied in this issue. However, it is hoped that the issuance of annual supplements will provide a means of maintaining a comprehensive collection of up-to-date statistical information for Newfoundland and Labrador.

The material selected for inclusion in this volume has been assembled for presentation in 23 sections. Each section contains a brief introduction which provides the source of the data for each table, as well as definitions, explanations and comments relating to the statistics. In each section the introduction is followed immediately by the statistical tables.

Much of the data contained in this original issue was obtained from publications which have been prepared and released by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. A limited amount of published and unpublished material was also obtained from Federal and Provincial Government departments and agencies. In addition, some previously unpublished statistical information was acquired from various divisions of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

In assembling this statistical volume no attempt was made to confine the search for information to any particular period of time. Indeed, efforts were made to go back as far as possible in constructing time series. However, in many cases these efforts were limited by changing statistical concepts and classifications, data inconsistencies and a lack of reliable source material. Much of the information presented will be found useful by persons engaged in planning and performing social and economic studies. Therefore, wherever possible, time series have been presented both in seasonally adjusted and unadjusted forms to facilitate economic analysis and forecasting.

Nevertheless, it is extremely difficult to design a useful information guide without knowing the full interests and needs of those who will ultimately use the material presented. For this reason a "mail back" information card has been included at the back of this volume. It is designed to aid in improving the usefulness of the series presented in subsequent publications by permitting adjustment to be made in the subjects presented in response to reader reaction and need. All suggestions, criticisms and corrections will be appreciated.
