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SEA FISHERIES AREAS OF NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

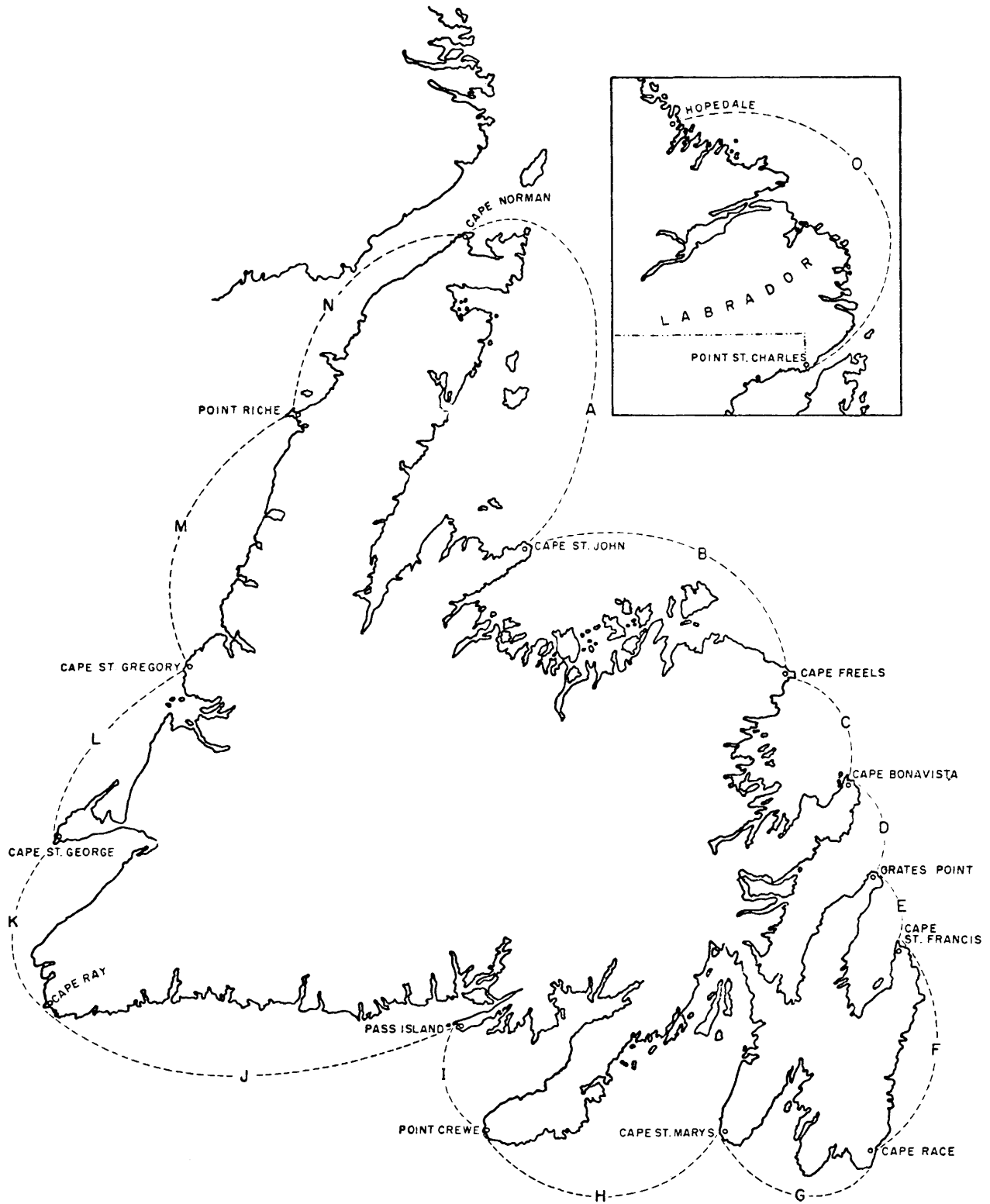

Full-time fishermen are defined as those who are engaged in the fishery for over 10 months of the year; part-time as those who are engaged in the fishery for a period of over five and up to 10 months; and casual as those who are engaged in the fishery for less than five months. "Engaged in the fishery"

includes, not only time spent in catching fish, but also time spent on shore preparing boats and fishing equipment, processing fish, repairing shore installations, and performing other unpaid activities connected with the fishery; and also time spent receiving unemployment insurance payments if such payments are earned as a result of fishing activities.
